


# New visitor parking options in the Southside

As a part of the **goBerkeley SmartSpace** pilot program

## Paid Visitor Parking in RPP Area I

October 17, 2022

## STARTING ON OCTOBER 17, 2022



New parking payment kiosks and signage will be installed on:

- **2700 blocks of Durant Avenue, Channing Way, and Haste Street**
- **2300 and 2400 blocks of Piedmont Avenue.**

### On October 17,

The City will introduce paid visitor parking in parts of Residential Preferential Parking (RPP) Area I to increase parking availability for residents and visitors.

#### Area I Annual & Visitor Permit Holders :

- Will be exempt from the new restrictions\*

#### Visitors without RPP Permits:

- May park up to 8 hours max at \$2.00/hour
- Payment required 8am-7pm, Monday to Friday\*

#### Payment Options:

- **Pay on your phone** using the ParkMobile (parkmobile.io) app (Zone #19800) **OR**
- **Pay by credit/debit card or coins** at a new parking kiosk
  - **\*New\*** Enter your license plate to register payment
  - Proceed to your destination without returning to your vehicle

\*Posted UC Berkeley football game day restrictions apply.

**goBerkeley SmartSpace** is a grant-funded pilot program studying ways to provide more visitor travel options and reduce frequent vehicle re-parking (shuffling) in the Southside and Elmwood neighborhoods. The City is also working with Telegraph and Elmwood businesses to provide more travel options for local employees. This winter, the City may change the hourly rate for visitors based on how parking is being used. In summer 2023, the City will conduct a full evaluation of the pilot program. Depending on the results, visitor paid parking in RPP Area I may be retained or removed.
